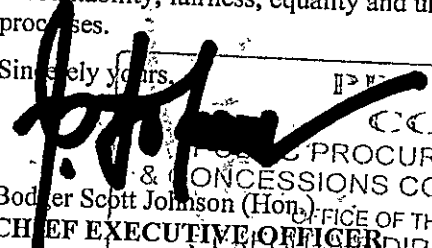

We respectfully request the Commission's approval for a reduction in the standard mandatory procurement lead-time from four (4) weeks to two (2) weeks for the following procurement packages:

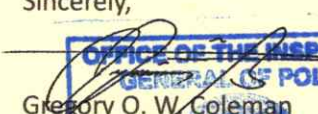
1. Petroleum Products
2. Spare Parts for Vehicle Repairs and Maintenance

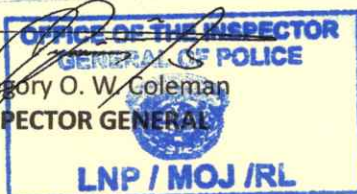
