Following a thorough review, the Commission observed that the budget which was approved by the Bomi County Council on December 31, 2024 was for Fiscal Year 2025. Kindly be informed that the period for which the Bomi County is requesting approval for Procurement Plan for has elapsed. In view of this, the Commission **cannot grant approval** to the Bomi County for its Procurement plan 2025 as the request is retroactive and inconsistent with Section 40 of the amended PCCA, 2026. Hence, the Commission **advises** that the Bomi County Administration kindly preparing its Annual Procurement Plan for Fiscal Year 2026 ensuring relevant activities are incorporated and that the plan is prepared based on a duly approved budget for this fiscal period (2026).

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain primarily in compliance with the PCCA, 2026, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.

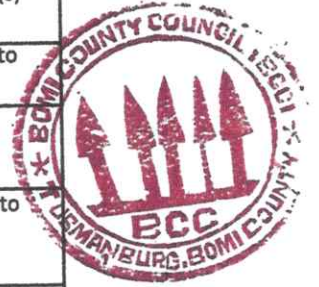
