

Additionally, the Ministry is seeking No Objection to use the manual system outside the online E-GP System.

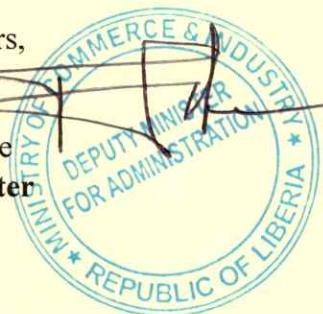
