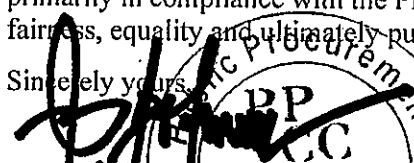
We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your communication dated September 11, 2025, which sought the approval of the Commission for the Liberia Electricity Corporation (LEC) to award contract to Auto Link Liberia for (Lot # I) at an estimated cost of one hundred ninety-four thousand one hundred twelve United States Dollars (US \$194,112.00) and (Lot # II) at an estimated cost of seventy-three thousand three hundred sixty-nine United States Dollars (US \$73,369.00) accumulating a total bid price of two hundred sixty-seven thousand four hundred eighty-one United States Dollars (US \$267,481.00) and to award contract Hayat Auto Spare and General Suppliers (Lot # III) at an estimated cost of twenty-one thousand nine hundred sixty-nine United States Dollars (US \$21,969.00), (Lot # IV) at an estimated cost of twenty-two thousand six hundred sixty-four United States Dollars (US \$22,664.00), (Lot # V) at an estimated cost of one forty-six thousand two hundred ten United States Dollars (US \$146,210.00) and (Lot # VI) at an estimated cost of nineteen thousand four hundred twenty-one United States Dollars (US \$19,421.00)) accumulating a total bid price of two hundred ten thousand two hundred sixty-four United States Dollars (US \$210,264.00) for the supply and delivery of vehicle spare parts ("the Goods"), respectively.

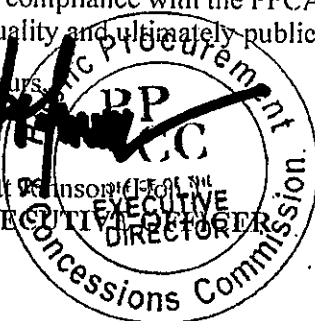
