Subject: **REQUEST FOR NO OBJECTION TO USE THE SOLE SOURCE METHOD OF PROCUREMENT TO AWARD A CONTRACT TO GUINEA SANITATION PUBLIC WORK AND CONSTRUCTION COMPANY INC (EGAP BTP-LIBERIA INC.) FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF ADDITIONAL MATERIALS UNDER THE ELWA JUNCTION - RIA CORRIDOR STREETLIGHT PROJECT**

We are pleased to extend our compliments and herewith request the commission's No Objection to use the Sole Source Method of Procurement for the Supply and Delivery of additional materials under the ELWA Junction – RIA Corridor Streetlight Project.

This project, which is vital to lighting one of the most critical corridors of LEC's network and the country, has become a priority for the national government, with the LEC taking the lead in ensuring that the corridor has high visibility and security for our traveling public using it daily.

The LEC intends to engage Guinea Sanitation Public Work and Construction Company Inc. (EGAP BTP-Liberia Inc.) on a sole-source basis for the Supply and Delivery of additional materials to enhance the smooth implementation of the ELWA Junction – RIA Corridor Streetlight Project, as the materials are available for immediate delivery. The project is expected to be commissioned before December 25, 2025. The reasons for Sole Sourcing EGAP BTP-Liberia Inc. are based on the following justifications:

1. Guinea Sanitation Public Work and Construction Company Inc. (EGAP BTP-Liberia Inc.), after our assessment and due diligence, is the only firm that has the materials available for immediate delivery to enhance the LEC efforts to meet the project completion timeline.
2. Guinea Sanitation Public Work and Construction Company Inc. (EGAP BTP-Liberia Inc.) has a proven track record of executing similar projects for the LEC (for example, the Monrovia–Bomi Corridor upgrade and the Kakata Corridor upgrade)

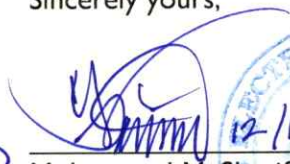

3. The contractor is currently executing the Agro Top Poultry facility project, which is nearing completion.

Given the above, consistent with Section 55 subsection (1) (a), (b), and (d) of the PPCC Act of 2010, the LEC requests a "NO OBJECTION" to use the Sole Source Method of Procurement to award a Contract to Guinea Sanitation Public Work and Construction Company Inc. (EGAP BTP-Liberia Inc.) for the Supply and Delivery of additional materials under the ELWA Junction – RIA Corridor Streetlight Project at a contract price of US\$441,000.00 (Four Hundred Forty-One Thousand United States Dollars).

Please be assured, Honorable Executive Director, that LEC will continue to strive to diligently abide by the provisions of the reinstated and amended PPC Act of 2010, as well as its accompanying regulations.

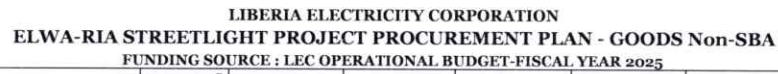
