Subject: **"NO OBJECTION" TO USE THE SOLE SOURCE METHOD OF PROCUREMENT TO AWARD CONTRACTS TO INSURANCE COMPANY OF AFRICA (ICA) FOR THE PROVISION OF MEDICAL AND LIFE INSURANCE COVERAGE AND AMERICAN UNDERWRITERS GROUP FOR THE PROVISION OF AUTO/LEET INSURANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2026**


We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated January 7, 2025, which sought the approval of the Commission for the Liberia National Police (LNP) to use the Sole Source method of procurement to award contracts to Insurance Company of Africa (ICA) for the provision of Medical and Life Insurance Coverage ("the Service") for an amount not to exceed one million three hundred thousand United States Dollars (US \$1,300,000.00) and American Underwriters Group (AUG) for the provision of Auto/Fleet Insurance Coverage for fleet ("the Service") for an amount not to exceed one hundred thousand United States Dollars (US \$ 100,000.00).

The Commission upon thorough review of your documentation submitted reveals LNP request was accompanied with adequate documentation and is in keeping with Section 55 (1) (b) of the PPCA, 2010. Therefore, the Commission **hereby** grants an approval to the Liberia National Police to use the Sole Source method of procurement to extend contract with Insurance Company of Africa (ICA) for the provision of Medical and Life Insurance Coverage ("the Service") at the above estimated cost.

However, the Commission **requests** that the Liberia National Police conduct an open competitive process (Restricted Bidding Method of Procurement) for the provision of Auto/Fleet Insurance Coverage so as to promote competition, wider participation of suppliers and value for money. The Commission herewith reduce the lead time of Restricted bidding method from four (4) weeks to two (2) weeks.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission admonishes and deems it a priority that you remain primarily in compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly aspire to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.
