Subj: **REQUEST FOR NO OBJECTION TO AWARD CONTRACT TO JUNGLE WATER GROUP OF INVESTMENT FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF SCRATCH CARDS OUTSIDE OF THE E-GP SYSTEM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025**

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your communication requesting the Commission's approval for the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning (MFDP) request as indicated above. Based on the review, the Commission is pleased to highlight the following:

- ❖ The Ministry of Finance and Development Planning submitted a comprehensive procurement package consisting of a transmittal letter, bidding document, invitation published online, procurement plan and explanatory notes, bid opening reports, and BEP recommendation for award.
- ❖ The MFDP employed the use of National Competitive Bidding method of procurement to invite bids. To this end, two bidders; (**Jungle Water Group of Investment and Saksoḳ Shopping Center**) submitted bids.
- ❖ Further review shows that the evaluation was done in accordance with the predetermined criteria indicated in the issued standard bidding document. As the process requires, a preliminary technical, and financial evaluation was done to examine bidders bid against the eligibility and qualification requirements. In view of this, an independent review of the process was carried out to ascertain that the proposed winner submitted all of the required document as stipulated in the entity's bidding document.
- ❖ The proposed winner, **Jungle Water Group of Investment** whose bid price at **US\$273,600.00 (Two Hundred Seventy-Three Thousand Six Hundred United States Dollars)** was technically responsive to the preliminary, technical, and financial requirement.

Based on the above, the Commission hereby grants a **"No Objection"** to the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning to award a contract to **jungle Water Group of Investment** for the supply and delivery of (57,000) Fifty-Seven Thousand Pieces of Scratch Cards at the estimated value of **US\$273,600.00 (Two Hundred Seventy-Three Thousand Six Hundred United States Dollars)** for the fiscal year 2025.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission emphasizes that it is a priority for you to remain compliant with the PPCA, 2010, as we jointly strive to achieve transparency, accountability, fairness, equality, and ultimately public confidence in our procurement and concessions processes.
