
We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your communication dated September 24, 2025, which sought the approval of the Commission for the Ministry of Public Works (MPW) to award contract to Alliance Consulting Engineers, Planners and Surveyors Inc. for the periodic maintenance of the St. John River Bridge ("the Works") at an estimated cost of four hundred eighty-nine thousand four hundred eighty-four United States Dollars and eight-eight Cents (US \$489,484.88).
