
The Commission, upon review of your submissions, highlights the following:

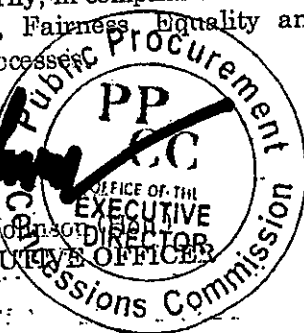

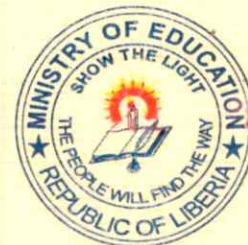
