RE: PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission (PPCC) hereby notifies bidders that participated in the Grand Cape Mount County Administration procurement process for the Construction and Renovation of the Grand Cape Mount County Administration Building in Robertsport City, Grand Cape Mount County, under **ITB No. MIA/GCMCA/CDF & SDF/NCB/001-11/2025**, that a Complaint/Request for Review has been filed with the **Complaints, Appeals and Review Panel (CARP)** by **Modern Consolidated Contractor (MCC), Inc.**, in keeping with **Part VIII, Section 129(1)** of the Amended and Restated Public Procurement and Concessions Act, 2026.

In its Complaint, Modern Consolidated Contractor (MCC), Inc. alleges that following its participation in the bidding process for the construction and renovation of the Grand Cape Mount County Administration Building, it received a **Notification of Contract Award dated May 18, 2026**, informing the company that its bid in the amount of **US\$150,739.50** had been accepted and that the notification of award would constitute the formation of the contract.

The Complainant further alleges the following:

1. That the Notification of Award and proceeding with preparations for the execution of the contract, it received a communication dated **July 2, 2026**, from the Grand Cape Mount County Administration informing it that the contract award had been **cancelled for “administrative reasons.”** According to the Complainant, the cancellation was based, among other things, on an allegation concerning an unfinished contract previously undertaken by an entity associated with the Complainant.
2. MCC, Inc. further alleges that the subsequent procurement decision favored **United Brothers Company (UBC)**, notwithstanding concerns raised by the Complainant regarding the successful bidder's compliance with the stated eligibility and evaluation requirements, including the submission of valid **LRA Tax Clearance, PPCC Vendor Certificate** and other relevant procurement documents. The Complainant also alleges a potential conflict of interest arising from an alleged relationship between the owner of UBC and an official associated with the Grand Cape Mount County Administration and Procurement Committee.
3. The Complainant contends that these circumstances raise concerns regarding the ***fairness, competitiveness, transparency and integrity of the procurement process*** and constitute potential violations of the applicable provisions of the Public Procurement and Concessions Act.

MCC, Inc. states that it previously filed a formal complaint with the Grand Cape Mount County Administration on August 3, 2026, requesting, among other things, an investigation into the conduct of the Procuring Entity, compliance with the Public Procurement and Concessions Act, and appropriate corrective action. The Complainant alleges that it received no acknowledgment or resolution of its complaint from the Procuring Entity and has consequently sought the intervention of the Commission.

In view of the foregoing, Modern Consolidated Contractor (MCC), Inc. has requested the Commission, through CARP, to investigate the conduct of the Procuring Entity and the procurement process, ensure compliance with the applicable provisions of the Amended and Restated Public Procurement and Concessions Act, 2026, and provide appropriate corrective directives in accordance with law.

Other participating bidders or interested parties who may be affected by the determination of this Complaint and who desire to appear and be heard are hereby requested to file their Notice of Appearance with the Complaints, Appeals and Review Panel (CARP) within **seven (7)** days upon publication of this Notice, in accordance with **Section 127(9)** of the Amended and Restated Public Procurement and Concessions Act, 2026
