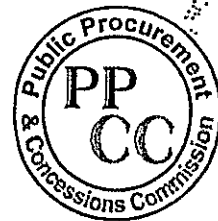

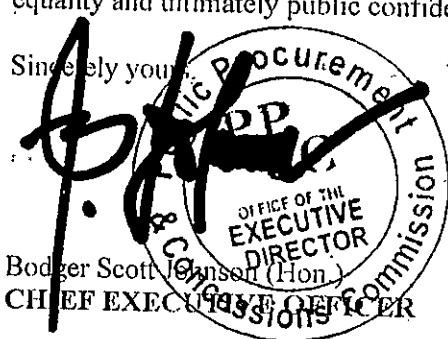

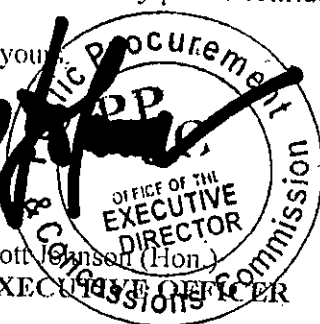

We present our compliments and wish to request the Commission approval for a special dispensation to manually use the Sole Source procurement method to hire the Services of MARSA MAROC for the mobilization of the rehabilitation of LMC PIER AND VESSEL HANDLING OPERATIONS ON THE LMC AND BMC PIERS consistent with Section 55 (d) of the restated PPCA 2010.

The request is predicated upon the immediate need to rehabilitate the PIER which is the gate way contributing to the economy of Liberia. The current state of the PIER is deplorable and has the propensity to stall the revenue generation by the possible reduction in the number of ships docking at the port of Monrovia.
