Subj: **QUERY ON REQUEST FOR NO OBJECTION TO AWARD CONTRACT TO ELSIE RENEWABLE POWER SOLUTION FOR THE INSTALLATION OF 75KVA OF SOLAR SYSTEM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025**

We present our compliments and wish to acknowledge receipt of your communication requesting the Commission's approval for the National Oil Company of Liberia (NOCAL) request as indicated above. Based on the review, the Commission is pleased to highlight the following:

- ❖ The National Oil Company of Liberia submitted a comprehensive procurement package consisting of a transmittal letter, issued bidding document, evaluation report, bidder's submission, and draft contract.
- ❖ The National Oil Company of Liberia (NOCAL) utilized the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) method to solicit bids for the referenced procurement activity. In response to the invitation, six (6) firms (*Eunola Design, The Visionary, Electrical Solar Technology, Go Solar Liberia Inc., Bermuda, and Elsie Renewable Power Solution*) submitted proposals within the stipulated timeframe. Subsequently, an independent review of the evaluation process was conducted to ensure compliance with the provisions of the Public Procurement and Concessions Act (PPCA) of 2010. The findings of this review are summarized in the matrix below, which outlines the respective standings of each bidder based on the evaluation criteria applied.

1.	Eunola Design	Didn't submit Article of Incorporation, Audited-Financial Statement, Bid Security, or evidence of financial capacity representing 30% of the bid price.	204,000.00
2.	Electrical Solar Technology	Didn't provide evidence of financial capacity, representing 30% of the bid price. The bid was also considered abnormally low according to NOCAL because of its price.	90,000.00
3.	The Visionary	Didn't submit Audited Financial Statement, Bid Security, Full Article of Incorporation, and evidence of financial capacity representing 30% of the bid price.	133,035.00
4.	Go Solar Liberia INC.	Didn't submit an Audited Financial Statement, evidence of financial capacity representing 30% of the bid price, and a power of Attorney that authorizes Mr. Daniel Geekor to act on behalf of the company.	358,577.45

5.	Bermuda	Didn't submit Audited Financial Statement, Bid Security, evidence of financial capacity representing 30% of the bid price, and Power of Attorney that authorizes Mr. Hadi Akhrass to act on behalf of the company.	199,790.00
6.	Elsie Renewable Power Solution	Didn't submit an Audited Financial Statement, documentary evidence that goods are ISO certified, and tropic resistance. Invalid certificate of product quality issued by a recognized laboratory accredited by the International Laboratory Accreditation Cooperation (ILAC) . Also, the evidence of financial capacity representing 30% of the bid price provided is not in compliance with the requirement.	222,300.00

In view of the foregoing, the Commission is unable to approve the National Oil Company of Liberia's (NOCAL) request at this time. This decision is based on the observation that none of the bidders were responsive to the key requirements stipulated in the bidding documents. Accordingly, the Entity is hereby requested to:

- ❖ Review and revise the bidding documents to ensure that all specifications, evaluation criteria, and qualification requirements are clear, measurable, and consistent with the PPCA of 2010 and its accompanying regulations;
- ❖ Re-advertise the procurement opportunity using the appropriate method of procurement to promote wider competition and transparency; and
- ❖ Submit the revised procurement package to the Commission for prior review and approval before proceeding with the retendering process.
- ❖ Retender the procurement process to ensure value for money and full compliance with the PPCA, 2010.

The Public Procurement and Concessions Commission reiterates the importance of full compliance with the PPCA, 2010, as we collectively strive to promote **transparency, accountability, fairness, and public confidence** in the national procurement and concessions processes.
