CABINET RESOLUTION NO. 7

**THE ESTABLISHMENT, REVITALIZATION, DEVELOPMENT, MANAGEMENT,
AND OPERATION OF THE LIBERIA AIRCRAFT REGISTRY**

WHEREAS, the Government of the Republic of Liberia recognizes the strategic importance of civil aviation to national economic growth, international trade, investment promotion, and global connectivity; and

WHEREAS, the United Nations Security Council, through Resolution 1343 (2001), adopted on March 7, 2001, under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations, imposed sanctions and restrictions on Liberia's aviation and related sectors during a period of regional instability and conflict in West Africa, including measures intended to address Liberia's alleged support for armed groups operating in neighboring Sierra Leone; and

WHEREAS, the Government of Liberia acknowledges the importance of continuing to strengthen transparency, international compliance, regulatory oversight, and responsible participation within the global aviation system in order to reinforce Liberia's international standing and credibility; and

WHEREAS, Liberia possesses the sovereign legal authority to maintain and operate a national aircraft registry under its laws and international aviation obligations, but such registry has remained underutilized and requires modernization and international repositioning; and

WHEREAS, the Government seeks to establish a credible, transparent, commercially viable, and internationally competitive aircraft registry capable of attracting aircraft owners, operators, financiers, lessors, and aviation stakeholders worldwide, while adhering to international aviation safety, compliance, and governance standards; and

WHEREAS, the Government, acting through the Liberia Civil Aviation Authority (LCAA), the Ministry of Transport, the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning, the National Investment Commission, and the Ministry of Justice, has negotiated a Management Agreement with Trust Middle East Company of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia for the revitalization, development, management, and operation of the Liberia Aircraft Registry; and

WHEREAS, the proposed arrangement preserves the sovereign authority and regulatory oversight of the Government of Liberia while enabling private sector investment, technical expertise, global marketing, and operational support necessary for the successful implementation of the registry;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CABINET OF THE REPUBLIC OF LIBERIA THAT:

1. The Cabinet approves the establishment, revitalization, modernization, development, management, and operation of the Liberia Aircraft Registry as a national strategic aviation initiative under the sovereign authority of the Republic of Liberia, pursuant to the provisions of the Liberia Civil Aviation Authority Act of 2019.
2. The Cabinet authorizes the Liberia Civil Aviation Authority (LCAA), in collaboration with the Ministry of Transport, the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning, the National Investment Commission, and the Ministry of Justice, to finalize and execute the Management Agreement with Trust Middle East Company of Saudi Arabia, consistent with Liberian law and applicable international aviation standards.
3. The Liberia Aircraft Registry shall operate as an official national aircraft registry of the Republic of Liberia, providing aircraft registration, recordation, certification support, transactional filing services, and related aviation registry services in accordance with applicable laws and international best practices.
4. The Government shall retain full sovereign authority over aviation safety oversight, public policy, regulatory approvals, treaty obligations, and all non-delegable governmental functions relating to civil aviation.
5. The Management Company shall be responsible for providing technical expertise, operational systems, global marketing, staffing, digital registry infrastructure, and commercial administration necessary for the implementation and growth of the Liberia Aircraft Registry.
6. The Cabinet directs all relevant Ministries, Agencies, and Commissions of Government to cooperate fully with the Liberia Civil Aviation Authority in facilitating the implementation of this initiative, including any necessary regulatory, administrative, legal, and institutional reforms required for operational effectiveness.

7. The Liberia Civil Aviation Authority shall provide periodic reports to Cabinet on implementation progress, operational performance, revenue generation, compliance measures, and international engagement relating to the Liberia Aircraft Registry.
8. This Resolution shall take immediate effect upon adoption by the Cabinet of the Republic of Liberia.
